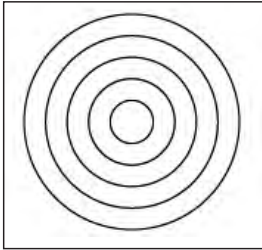
Impress your loved one with a bouquet of flowers that you can send digitally. *Happy Valentine's Day* to you.”

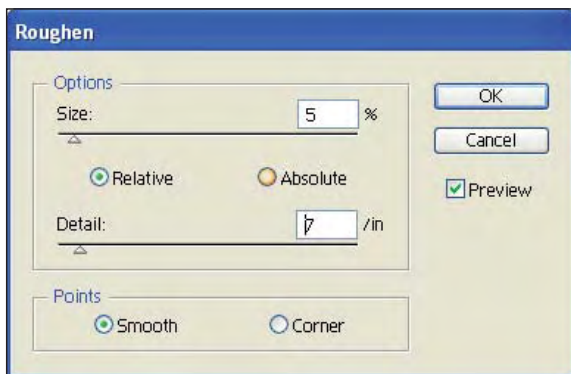
## Create the polar grid

- 1) With the **Polar Grid tool** (  ), click and drag to draw the circular rings.
- 2) Without releasing the mouse, press **Arrow Left** to decrease the number of dividers and press **Arrow Up** or **Arrow Down** to adjust the number of rings.

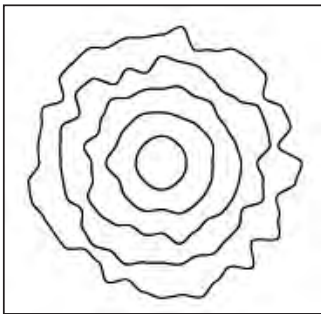


## Use Effects to create your flowers

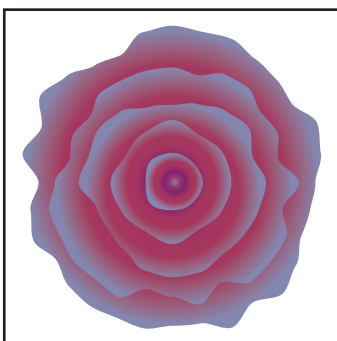
- 3) With the polar grid still selected, choose **Effect > Distort and Transform > Roughen**.



- 4) Adjust the size and detail according to your preference, using the Preview as a guide.



- 5) Fill the flower with a Radial Gradient.



## More variations that you can use

- 6) With the same polar grid, you can try these grids for more effects.
